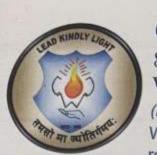

In addition, they will select from Inter-disciplinary Courses (IDC), Ability Enhancement Courses (AEC), Value Added Courses (VAC), and Skill Enhancement Courses (SEC) from the available pool of courses. The subjects offered for Single Major and Single Minor courses in B.A., B.Com., and B.C.A. programs are specified, and students must select their courses accordingly.

Course from the remaining combinations. The selected courses must align with the students' academic goals and should be chosen with careful consideration.

G. Inter-disciplinary Courses (IDC): All undergraduate students must complete 3 introductory-level IDC courses related to broad disciplines different from those studied at the Higher Secondary level. Students are not permitted to repeat courses previously studied at the Higher Secondary level under this category.

H. Ability Enhancement Courses (AEC): Students enrolled in Single Major and Single Minor courses will study Compulsory English in the 2nd semester and either MIL Nepali or Alternative English in the 3rd semester. Students in the Three Discipline Specific Courses (Multidisciplinary) program will study Compulsory English in the 3rd semester and either MIL Nepali or Alternative English in the 2nd semester.

I. Value Added Courses (VAC): Environmental Education and Understanding India will be mandatory VACs in the respective semesters as per the course structure.

J. Skill Enhancement Courses (SEC): Students will choose from a pool of three Skill Enhancement Courses designed to provide value-based or skill-based knowledge.

K. Career-Oriented Programs: The College will continue to offer two career-oriented programs alongside B.A., B.Com., and B.C.A. degrees: Communicative and Functional English: Offered as a one-year certificate, two-year diploma, and three-year advanced diploma. Computer Applications: Offered as a one-year certificate, two-year diploma, and three-year advanced diploma.

The above resolutions were unanimously agreed upon and will be implemented for the 2024-2025 academic session at Cluny Women's College, Kalimpong.
